



Dress Code for Pre School & Junior School

A clean, tidy, neat appearance is expected of pupils at all times. Maintaining a high standard of dress while wearing the school Dress Code and Sports Uniform is part of the training we seek to give pupils here at school. We believe that the Dress Code enhances our children's dignity and respect for themselves and others.

Pre-School

All children must wear an overall in school.

All children should wear a tracksuit and runners for Gym days.

Junior School

The Dress Code as specified below must be worn coming to and going home from school for children from Kinder A to Class 6

A proper fitting

- Kilt of their choice, plain or tartan, properly kilted, (elastic at the waist for KA & KB) worn below the knee.
- White shirt with a collar, which should be always tucked in.
- Co-ordinating woollen plain coloured cardigan / jumper.
- Plain dark shoes, No canvas, sport shoes or casual boots may be worn in school.
- Ankle/knee length socks or tights.
- A plain coat, anorak, jacket or raincoat. No labels or logo permitted.
- A pink gingham smock for Art/Crafts is required to be worn over their kilts. KA & KB wear smocks at all times.
- Hair should be clean and tidy and tied back from face. No scarves should be worn.
- A bracelet, a ring and one pair of stud earrings may be worn. No nail varnish and no make up permitted

Note:

The following **may not be worn** in school: designer/lettered or label tops, pleated skirts, scarves, polo necks, sweatshirts, sport shirts or sloppy cardigan/jumper. Runners may not be worn outside PE.

SPORTS UNIFORM

Children from Kinder A to Class 6 must wear the Teresian School tracksuit which is available from

The Sports Uniform consists of:

- Teresian Junior School Tracksuit for all
- a plain white collared aertex shirt
- royal blue Teresian shorts (for classes 5 & 6)
- Predominantly white runners and white socks
- Gymnastics shoes available from Dance World

For Hockey

- Children in Classes 2-6 require a hockey stick, gum shield and shin pads. Shoe bag required for gum shield ,pads and gym shoes.

For Basketball/Tennis

- Children in Classes 1-6 require a tennis racquet and a basketball for Summer Term. Please ensure that the correct size basketball is purchased (classes 1-4 need size 4 and classes 5-6 need size 5).

Please Note

All clothes worn to school should be clean, properly pressed and the correct size and should be clearly marked with the student's name. When choosing clothes for school, it is recommended to buy clothes that are easy to wash, dry-clean or press. This is essential to maintain the tidy appearance requested of students at all times.

Regular checks of the Dress Code will be carried out throughout the year.
