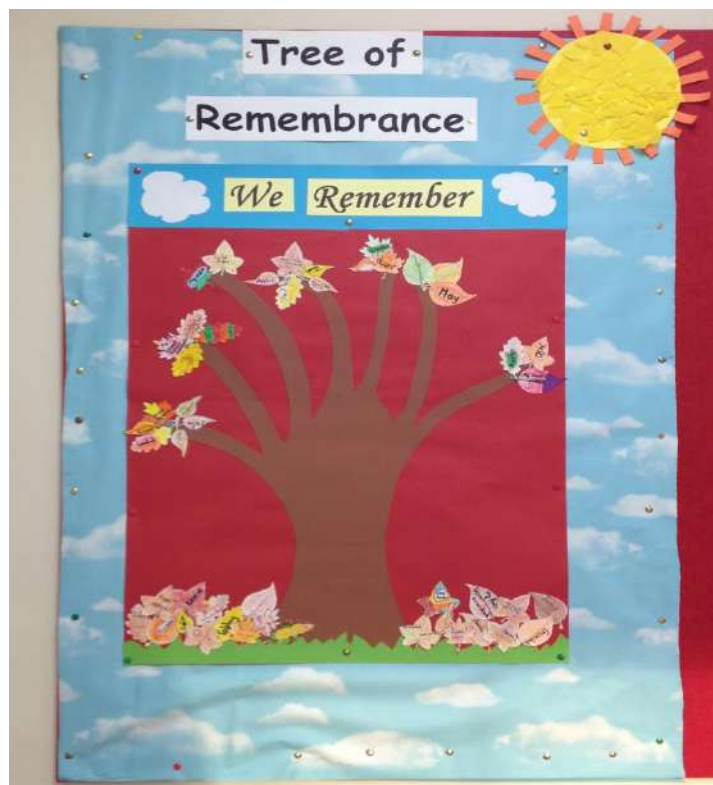


November
