

# Matriculation



# National University of Ireland (NUI)

- **Standard Requirement:** Candidates must obtain a pass in at least six subjects, with at least a Grade H5 in two subjects on the Higher Course and at least Grade H7 (Higher Course) or O6 (Ordinary Course) in four subjects.
  - Foundation Level Irish is not accepted for Matriculation Registration purposes.
- Foundation Level Mathematics is accepted for Matriculation Registration purposes but not as a substitute for the subject Mathematics in faculties or courses for which the subject Mathematics is currently an entry requirement.

# Trinity College

**The minimum matriculation requirements are:**

1) Six subjects, three of which must be at Grade 5 or above on Higher Leaving Certificate papers.

2) These six subjects must include:

A pass in English

**AND**

A pass in mathematics (or foundation-level mathematics) and a pass in a language other than English

***N.B.: Some courses will have additional requirements and restrictions for admission. They will be detailed on the relevant course page and on the Admission Requirements page.***

## Additional Notes and Restrictions

- A pass means grade O6/H7 or above on ordinary or higher papers in the Leaving Certificate.
- Mathematics at foundation-level is acceptable for minimum entry requirements only, for all courses except nursing or midwifery courses. Irish at foundation-level is not acceptable for minimum entry requirements, course requirements or for scoring purposes.
- Combinations of Leaving Certificate subjects not permitted:

Physics/Chemistry may not be presented with physics or chemistry.

Biology and agricultural science may not be presented as two of the six subjects required for minimum entry purposes, and they may not be presented together to satisfy course specific requirements. However, both may be used for scoring purposes.

Art and music may not be offered as two of the three higher Leaving Certificate grades for minimum entry requirements but both may be used for scoring purposes.

# Dublin City University (DCU)

A minimum of six Leaving Certificate subjects at Grade 06/H7, to include the subjects English OR Irish AND the subject Mathematics. In addition, applicants must present at least two subjects at grade H5.

## **Exception:**

Bachelor of Education (Primary Teaching) (DC002, DC003 and DC004)

A minimum of six Leaving Certificate subjects at Grade 06/H7, to include a H5 in Irish, 05/H7 in English and 06/H7 in Mathematics. Applicants must present at least three subjects at grade H5.

**N.B.: Additional course requirements are indicated in the prospectus.**

DCU does not award points for the subject of Mathematics (Leaving Certificate - Foundation Level). This subject will be accepted for admission purposes into the University for some courses, please check prospectus.



# Dublin City University (DCU)

Certain subjects will not be scored separately if they occur in combination with subjects which are similar in content. In each case the highest individual grade will be scored. The following six groups of subjects are affected by this restriction:

- 1) Music and Musicianship, Music A, Music B
- 2) Economics, Agricultural Economics
- 3) Physics with Chemistry
  - if combined with Physics and Chemistry only the two best scored
  - if combined with Physics or Chemistry only the best scored
- 4) History, Economics and Economic History
  - if all three are taken only the best two will be scored
- 5) Latin, Classical Studies
- 6) Greek, Classical Studies

# Institutes of Technology

For Level 7/8 courses candidates must obtain a Grade H5 in **two/three subjects** on the Higher Course and at least Grade H7 (Higher Course) or O4/O6 (Ordinary Course) in **four subjects**.

For Level 6 courses candidates must obtain a O6/H7 in five Leaving Certificate subjects.

These six/five subjects must include English **OR** Irish **AND** Maths

Foundation Level Maths is accepted for the purposes of entry requirements in the case of any programme where Higher or Ordinary Level Maths is not a requirement. Points will not be awarded.

Foundation Level Irish is not accepted for the purposes of entry requirements or for points.
